

REMOVAL OF SIGNATURE FROM RECALL PETITION

A voter who has signed an initiative or referendum petition, and who subsequently wishes his or her name withdrawn, may do so by filing a written request with the appropriate elections official for the withdrawal of their signature. The written request must include the voter’s name, residence address, and signature, and must be filed in the elections official’s office prior to the date the petition is filed. (California Elections Code section 9602). A voter may submit the following information to the City Clerk to withdraw his or her name from an initiative or referendum petition he or she has signed.

The request must have an original “wet” signature. Faxed, emailed, and/or scanned copies cannot be accepted.

I have signed the initiative or referendum petition indicated below and hereby request my name be withdrawn from the petition.

The persons circulating the petition have falsely represented the reasons to recall, and misrepresented it as being a Citizens Initiative when in fact, it was crafted by and is being paid for by an out-of-town special interest drug dealer.

***Their deadline to file this petition is June 21, 2022. Withdrawal requests should be submitted to the City Clerk with a sense of urgency, well before the deadline date.**
